Braden Smith of Colfax Troop 753 selected for his Eagle Scout Project to construct, assemble, paint and install seven sets of shelves with storage bins in the Caring Center in Lebanon. With a fully funded United Way Youth as Resources Grant Brandon received a check for \$998.17. With Brandon's project and the help of his Troop the Caring Center will benefit from better organization of its donations. The goal of the Caring Center is to provide help to families in poverty and to help them get out of poverty by achieving self-sustainability. On the Caring Centers website it states that in 2010 over 2,366 families received assistance. Brandon became familiar with this grant when a presentation was given by Amy Hammerle at a roundtable meeting in late 2014.

Boone County Youth as Resources (YAR) is a program that funds youth led projects and promotes volunteerism from all youth. So if you have an idea or project that will better the community you can apply for a grant and receive up to \$1000. Funds may be used on community or Eagle Scout projects.
