Popcorn 2014

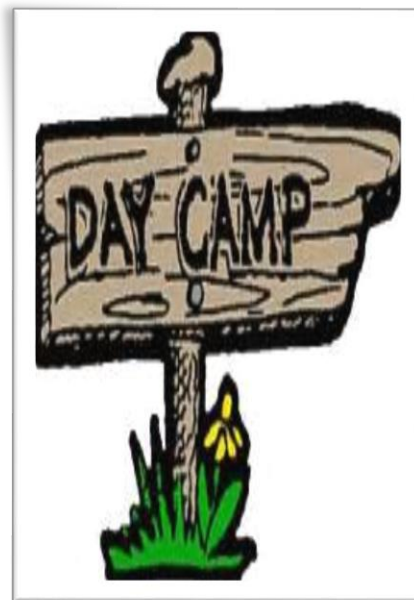
