Cubmaster / Scoutmaster of the Year

These awards recognize a Cubmaster and a Scoutmaster from our district who have done an outstanding job of leading their unit over the past year.

Pack/Troop Committee Chair of the Year

These awards recognize the committee chair of a pack and a troop in our district who have done an outstanding job of keeping their unit organized and functioning smoothly over the past year.

Chartered Partner of the Year

This award recognizes a Chartering Organization who has been an outstanding partner with the Boy Scouts of America over the past year in supporting their unit(s).

Universal Award

This award recognizes new or new-ish (1-2 yrs) Scouters who have been willing to jump in and lend a hand where needed, either with their unit or with the district.

Spark Plug Award

This award recognizes people who energize the people around them and constantly demonstrate the Spirit of Scouting.

Long Rifle Award

The Sugar Creek Long Rifles are persons who have proved their steadfast purpose through years of service (5+) to the Sugar Creek District program. They serve as a bulwark against the deterioration of the program by serving much as the Minutemen did in the early years of our country. Presented on a ratio of 1:25 units.
